Coach,

We are looking forward to having you to our annual Mid Summer Classic tournament on June 16-18, 2006. For 2006, the tournament will feature 3 age groups and 43 of the top teams from Pennsylvania, Maryland, Virginia, New Jersey, New York, West Virginia, Delaware, and Ontario, Canada!

- **Format:** Pool play will begin Friday the 16<sup>th</sup> with most fields starting at 1:00. Teams playing Friday will play 3 games for a total of 6 pool games. Teams will finish playing pool play games on Saturday the 17<sup>th</sup>. Teams not playing the 3 games of pool Friday will only have 3 pool games. The teams choosing not to play Friday will have the results of their 3 games Saturday doubled to make 6 total games of pool play for all teams. Championship play will begin first thing Sunday morning. All teams losing their first game are scheduled for a consolation games, so all teams have at least two Sunday games.
  
- **Rain Phone:** In case of inclement weather, the rain phone number will be 717.300.1300. Please appoint only **one person per team** to access this number. The recording will be kept current and include any changes or cancellations if they happen. An email will also be sent to the contact person should anything happen and updates will be made on the website in the case of heavy rain or other conditions. Generally a decision is made around 5:00-5:30 am for the entire day and a recording is usually up by 6 am. We attempt to call all teams in a timely manner should this occur.
  
- **Team Cancellation:** If at any time you find out your team will not be able to participate, please let us know ASAP to be considered for future tournaments. If a team cancels, all teams scheduled to play them will be notified if a replacement team cannot be found. Should this happen, we may consolidate the bracket and have teams gaining forfeits play each other. In this case, teams will be notified of changes by email.
  
- **Directions** and addresses for all the parks can be found on our website, <http://pa-softball.com/directions.html> Currently no major construction along major corridors is known.

- **Concessions/Trash:** Concessions will be available at all parks for the tournament. **You are not allowed to bring food into some parks, particularly Heishman's Softball Complex.** Please help our field staff by picking up after your team. Any items found during the tournament will be kept at the park concession stand.
- **Pool play brackets** are enclosed and are also posted online. Any changes to the brackets will be emailed to the contact person and also posted on the website. If any changes made within 48 hours of the tournament affect your Saturday morning start time you will be notified by phone. Any other changes will be made by email and posted online. To see if you have the most up to date brackets, check the "Last Modified" mark on the bottom left of the page to make sure it matches your copy. If there are changes to a bracket due to rain or a team dropping at the last minute, updated brackets will be made available at check in.
- **Championship bracket seeds** will be available by phone approximately an hour after the last pool play game in your age has been completed. **DO NOT CALL US SATURDAY EVENING;** you will be called by your field director with your seed. Be sure to leave (1) active cell phone number with the field director at check-in (only 1 number will be called). This number will be called and if not available a message will be left. Brackets will also be posted online Saturday evening. Incoming calls will not be answered until all teams are called with seeds. If you want detailed bracket information you'll need to get it online.
- **Hersheypark:** Quite a few teams that have entered tournament will be attending Hersheypark, a nearby theme park that has over 60 rides and does catered picnics. The park has given us a discount rate of \$28.50/person for adults (regular \$41.95) on tickets when pre-purchased. More info is available on our website or by calling 717.300.1300.
- **A Team Picture** will be taken of most teams at the tournament. Samples for ordering will be available on Saturday and Sunday under the canopy.
