Coach,

We are looking forward to having your team to our annual Memorial Day Madness tournament on May 28-30, 2016. For 2016, the tournament will feature 5 age groups and 231 of the top teams from throughout the East Coast and Canada. We are excited about having teams from PA, MD, NJ, NY, VA, WV, DE, CT, OH, and Canada represented this year!

- **Format:** Pool play will begin Saturday the 28<sup>th</sup> with most fields starting between 8 and 9am. Teams will finish playing pool play games on Sunday the 29<sup>th</sup>. Most teams will play 3 play games Saturday and 3 more Sunday, but because some schedule changes are inevitable, some may have a slightly different schedule (4 one day, 2 another). While we've gone over the brackets several times, all teams should be scheduled for 6 pool play games – if not let me know ASAP. Championship play will begin first thing Monday morning. Teams losing their first game on Monday will either play in a playback bracket or in a few instances, a consolation game, so all teams will have at least 2 Monday games.
  
- **Inclement Weather:** In case of inclement weather, we will have our automated phone system call both your primary and secondary contacts should there be any changes. We will call teams as soon as a decision is made if we need to push games back or cancel any games.
  
- **Team Cancellation:** If at any time you find your team will not be able to participate, please let us know ASAP to be considered for future tournaments. If/when a team cancels, all teams scheduled to play them will be notified if a replacement team cannot be found. Should this happen, we may consolidate the bracket and have teams that would otherwise have forfeited games paired up to play each other. In this case, teams will be notified of changes by email. We will eliminate forfeits when given sufficient notice to adjust the bracket. Changes will be noted in bold on brackets.
  
- **Directions** and addresses for all the parks can be found on our website, <http://pa-softball.com/directions.pdf>
  
- **Parade Schedule:** Chambersburg typically has a parade on Monday around the Rt. 30 West area (South Hamilton/St. Thomas). Please leave a few extra minutes to get there. Historically it's been roughly 9am.
  
- **Concessions/Trash:** Concessions are expected to be available at all parks for the tournament. The concessions at tournaments are one of if not the biggest fundraiser of the year for many of the local youth leagues hosting you on their fields. Currently coolers are allowed at all parks (no grills at South Hamilton)...please don't be the one that ruins it for everyone else by leaving a big mess or alcohol containers (also, alcohol is strictly prohibited at ALL parks). Any items found during the tournament are generally kept at the park concession stand. Check at the concession stand for lost items or following the tournament, email us regarding any unfound equipment and we will try to locate it for you.

- **Pool play brackets** are enclosed and are also posted online. Any changes to the brackets will be emailed to the contact person and also posted on the website. If any changes are made within 48 hours of the tournament and affect your Saturday morning start time you will be notified by phone. Any other changes will be made by email and posted online. To see if you have the most up to date brackets, check the “Last Modified” mark on the bottom left of the page to make sure it matches your copy. If there are changes to a bracket due to rain or a team dropping at the last minute, updated brackets will be made available at check in. **Changes to the original schedule will be marked in bold.**
- **Championship brackets/seeds** : Unless a different number is given at least 72 hours PRIOR to the tournament, the numbers you provided and verified when you registered team will be called with seeding information by our automated phone system with seeding information. This number will be called and if not available a message will be left. Brackets will also be posted online and coaches will be emailed brackets once pool play games are completed and championship brackets have been finalized. Coaches should check the pool play results posted at the game site before leaving each day. Once seedings are released, all seeds become final. **Score slips are kept by the umpire. Each team should sign to verify the score and winning team. Please check your scores before leaving to ensure they get reported properly.**
- **Hersheypark** is a major attraction in the area with over 60 rides, shows, a zoo and Chocolate World. Once again the park has given us a great discount group ticket price of \$42.00/person for adults (regular \$61.95) when pre-purchased using the online order form. More info is available on our website or by emailing director@pa-softball.com <http://www.pa-softball.com/hersheypark.pdf>
- **Tournament T-shirt** orders are being taken. Only team orders will be taken in advance. This is a good way to assure your sizes are available. T-shirt stands will only be available at the largest parks, and not all sizes may be available at the tournament. Pre-orders must be in the Monday prior to the tournament and can be emailed to director@pa-softball.com. See the website for an order form. Only pre-orders of 8 pieces or more accepted. With the purchase of a pre-ordered shirt, you can purchase a “Bin” item for \$5 (includes some shorts, flannels, t-shirts, etc.) [http://www.pa-softball.com/tournament\\_shirt.pdf](http://www.pa-softball.com/tournament_shirt.pdf)
- **Team Pictures** will be taken of most teams at the tournament. Samples for ordering will be available on Sunday and Monday.
- **All Star Helmets** will once again be attending the tournament. They specialize in custom batting helmets, but they can also airbrush other items. Call Chris at 706-934-5008 for more info and to see what parks they will be at. They will be at several parks during the course of the weekend.

# 2016 PA SOFTBALL PARK DIRECTIONS

Some addresses are "ballparked", true address may be unknown or may not have an address

## Chambersburg Area Fields (Access from PA Turnpike, Interstate 81, Rt. 30, Rt. 11)

### **South Hamilton (4 fields) – 832 Warm Spring Rd, Chambersburg, PA 17201**

Take Interstate-81 to Exit 16 (Rt 30/Lincolnway). Turn on Rt. 30 West. Continue through Chambersburg about 3.3 miles. At the top of a long hill, turn left onto 995 West and continue on 995 for about 1.5 miles.

**Green Village Softball Complex (4 fields)-** Take Interstate-81 to Exit 20 (Scotland). Turn North on 997. Go 2.6 miles the red light (intersection of Rt. 11). Go through the light 0.1 mile. Turn right on Green village Rd. Go 0.1 mile. The fields will be on the left. **From Shippensburg**, take Rt. 11 South to the intersection of Rt. 977/11. Turn right @ light –follow above. Please use the additional parking facility in the back of park, accessible from Eiser Dr. (.2 mile past Greenvillage Rd. on 997.) Do not park in the church parking lot on Sunday morning!  
**From Turnpike:** Take 997 South 15 miles to Green Village Road. Turn left and another left into the park.

**Heishman's Softball Complex (4 fields) - 398 Centerville Road, Newville, PA 17241**  
**Take Interstate 81 to Newville exit (Exit 37). Turn on route 233 North (Right turn from North, Left turn from South) for exactly 2.5 miles. You will pass through an intersection with blinking lights on the way (intersection of Rt. 233/ Rt.11). Fields are about 1.5 miles from the lights on the left hand side, clearly visible from the road.**

## Hagerstown, MD Area Fields (Access from PA Turnpike East/I-68 to I-70, I-64, I-78 S to I-81, Rt. 11)

### **Pinesburg Softball Complex (4 fields) - 15323 Clear Spring Rd, Williamsport, MD 21795**

Can be reached by taking Rt. 11 South into Williamsport. At the 3<sup>rd</sup> traffic light in Williamsport, turn right. Complex is approximately 3 miles on the left. From I-81 South, take Exit 2 (Williamsport). Bear to the right at the end of the exit ramp. At the 3<sup>rd</sup> light make a right turn. Approximately 2 miles on the left is the entrance to the park. Note: You'll see a white fence on the right hand side of the road just before the entrance to the park. Park entrance is hidden by trees.

### **Marty Snook Park (3 fields) - 17901 Halfway Blvd, Hagerstown, MD 21740**

**From I-81** take Halfway Blvd Exit (Exit 5 in MD). Follow exit ramp onto Halfway Blvd (Valley Mall will be on right). Follow Halfway Blvd 2.2 miles to Marty L Snook Memorial Park on right. **From I-70 West**, Exit onto Exit 28. At end of ramp, go straight. Park is 100 yards on Left.

### **Kemps Mill (3 fields) - 11114 Kemps Mill Rd., Williamsport, MD 21795**

From I-81, take Exit for Rt. 11 (towards Williamsport). At Sheetz, turn right onto Rt. 63 for approximately 1 mile, then turn right onto Kemps Mill Rd. AFTER the church (there are two ways to turn onto Kemps Mill Rd.). Make another right, and complex is immediately on your left. From I-70 West, take Exit 24 (Williamsport/Huyett). Make Left at bottom of off-ramp. Go 9/10 of a mile to Kemps Mill Rd. Make a Right on Kemps Mill Rd (just past Gateway Ministries). Road turns right at bottom of hill. The complex is on your left-hand side (just pass the turn).

### **Charlotte Prather (3 fields) - 119 Ryneal St, Martinsburg, WV 25401**

Turn left onto Boyds Gap Rd/W King St/Tuscarora Pike. Continue to follow W King St for 1.6 mi. Turn right onto S Queen St for 0.2 mi. Turn left at the 2nd cross street onto E Stephen St for 0.3 mi. Make a Slight right onto Sycamore St for 0.2 mi. Sycamore St turns left and becomes Ryneal St for a few hundred feet.

**Hagerstown Fairgrounds (3 fields) - 420 North Mulberry St, Hagerstown, MD 21740**

From the North-Directions from Interstate 81: Merge onto I-40E, Exit 6A (2 miles). Make a left onto N. Cannon Ave. (2 miles). Make a right onto MD-64/Jefferson St. Make a left onto N. Cleveland Ave. The park entrance will be at the end of the road. **From Washington:** Take 270 Spur North to I-70 N toward Hagerstown. Take US 40W, Exit 32B toward Hagerstown. Make a right onto MD-64 S. Cleveland Ave. The park entrance will be at the end of the road. **From Baltimore:** Take I-695 N toward Towson. Take Exit 16, I-70 W toward Frederick. Take US 40W, Exit 32B toward Hagerstown. Make a right onto MD-64 S. Cleveland Ave. The park entrance will be at the end of the road.

**Mechanicsburg/Harrisburg Area Fields (Access from PA Turnpike, Rt. 11/15, I-81, I-83, and Rt. 22/322 )**

**Lower Allen Park (3 fields) - 4094 Lisburn Rd, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055**

From Mechanicsburg, take US 15 South to Rossmoyne Exit (just North of Pennsylvania Turnpike). Turn left (from North)/right (from South) onto Rossmoyne Road. Proceed 1.3 miles to Lisburn Road. Turn right onto Lisburn Road. After a short distance (0.1 mile), road forms a "Y"...bear left (Arcona Road is on right). Proceed South on Lisburn Road 2.2 miles to Park/fields (entrance on left).

**Roof Park (5 fields) - 599 Lewisberry Road, New Cumberland 17070**

**McCollum (1 field) - 684 Ross Ave, New Cumberland, PA 17070**

Take I-83 to Exit 39A, Capital City Airport (1 exit South of PA Turnpike interchange). **To Roof Park** - Turn left onto Lewisberry Rd (PA 114 West/Lewisberry Rd). Go approximately 2.0 miles to fields on right. **To McCollum** From exit 39A ramp, turn right, go to the 3rd light on 114 East (Turkey Hill on right). Make a left onto Old York Rd. Go to the 2nd light and make a right onto Ross Ave. Go approx. 1 mile and the field is on the left hand side. Do not mistake the field for Mickle field, which is about 1/2 mi before New Market. **To Roof from McCollum** : Head back towards where you got off the I-83 exit and continue on 114 West (about 2 miles past the exit). The fields will be on your right hand side.

**Friendship Community Park (3 Fields) - 1901 Fisher Road, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055**

**From the east, west, or north,** take either I-81 or the PA Turnpike (76) to Rt 15 South in Mechanicsburg. Take the PA-114 exit toward Mechanicsburg/Bowmansdale. Turn right onto PA-114 W/S Market St. Turn left on the Gettysburg Pike for 0.7 mile. Turn right onto Fisher Road for 0.6 mile. Park will be on the left - 1st entrance is baseball, second entrance is softball. **From the south,** take Rt. 15 North to the Lisburn Road exit. Turn left onto State Route 2004/W Lisburn Road for 0.1 mile. Turn right onto Gettysburg Pike for 0.8 mile. Turn left on Fisher Road, go 0.6 mile to park, turn left into second park entrance.

**Stony Ridge Park (4 Fields) - 50 Bernheisel Bridge Road, Carlisle, PA 17015**

**From all directions,** take I-81 to Exit 52 (US-11/PA Turnpike) *heading North on Rt 11*. Continue North on Rt 11 for 1.8 mile. Take left at Hess onto Ridge Hill Road for .2 mile. Bernheisel Bridge Rd will be on the left. Go a short distance and the park will be on the right hand side.

**Upper Allen Community Park - (4 fields) - 901 E. Winding Hill Rd, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055**

**From 15 North,** exit at Cumberland Parkway toward Winding Hill. Left on Gettysburg Rd. First Left on E. Winding Hill Rd. Turn left at light to stay on E. Winding Hill Rd. thru light. Fields are about 1.5 miles on left. **From 15 South,** exit at Cumberland Parkway. Make left at light onto E. Winding Hill Rd. Fields are about 1.5 miles on left

**Paul Walter Park (3 fields) - 98 Elm St, Mechanicsburg, PA 17050**

Follow I-81 N to PA-114 E in Silver Spring Township. Take exit 57 from I-81. Turn right onto PA-114 E 1.7 mi. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto US-11. 0.5 mi. Turn right onto Birch St/Maple Dr. Continue to follow Maple Dr. 0.2 mi. Turn left onto Elm St

# 2016 PA SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament Website: <http://pa-softball.com>

- ❖ **Check In:** Insurance information, birth certificates, and your roster (we will hold onto a copy of roster only) shall be presented to the field director at the complex headquarters before your first game. Headquarters are usually near the concession area. You will also be asked to verify the name of the contact person, hotel information, and contact #.
- ❖ **Tournament Rules**
- ❖ **Time limit – All games (80 minutes)** – The winners bracket championship final game will have no time limit
  - A new inning starts at the completion of the 3<sup>rd</sup> out by the home team of the previous inning
  - No drop dead rule, however, we will not finish an inning if the home team is winning & batting when time expires
  - Game time begins at the conclusion of pre-game meeting. The official clock shall be declared by the umpires
  - The official clock will only stop during lengthy delays (determined at umpire's discretion)
  - Stalling will not be tolerated and may result in another inning being played. Umpire judgment is FINAL.
- ❖ **Speed up rules will apply**
  - In an attempt to get in a full 7 innings of play, a pitcher will receive 5 warm ups the first inning, 3 every inning thereafter. A new pitcher will receive 5 warm ups.
  - Infield/Outfield balls will be permitted the 1<sup>st</sup> inning only. No team huddles between innings. 1 minute between innings.
- ❖ **“Run Ahead Rule”** as follows will be in place for ALL games:
  - 12 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings, and 8 runs after 5 innings
- ❖ **International Tie Breaker (ITB)**
  - In **Pool Play** games, one inning of ITB will be played to break ties if the time limit has not expired
    - Ties will be recorded as such in pool play after 80 minutes has elapsed
  - In **Elimination Round** games, ITB will begin after 80 minutes has elapsed or 7 innings have been played (whichever comes first). We will play until a winner has been declared
    - The last batter due up on the offensive team will be placed on 2<sup>nd</sup> base to start each inning in ITB
      - **NOTE:** A substitute with eligibility may be used to pinch run in this situation as the runner
- ❖ **Championship Play seeding criteria**, and if necessary the tournament winner shall be based upon (in order):
  - Points Per Game (Win = 2 points, Tie = 1 point, Loss = 0 points, Forfeit = (-1) point)
  - Least Runs Allowed Per Game
  - Most Runs Scored Per Game
  - Flip of a coin
    - **NOTE:** A forfeit is a 7-0 win. Games will only count if complete. All 6-0 teams will be seeded ahead of all 3-0 teams and 0-3 teams will be seeded ahead of all 0-6 teams when teams have an unequal # of games.
- ❖ **Equipment**
  - **Batting helmets must be NOSCAE stamped and have a approved facemask (no chinstrap requirement)**
  - Jewelry must be removed with the exception of a medical alert bracelet. Any violation of this rule will require removal and re-entry use of that player. If it cannot be removed, she cannot play.
  - **14&U and up** are permitted to wear metal cleats
- ❖ **Offensive Team**
  - A **courtesy runner (CR)** can be used for the pitcher and/or the catcher at any time. The same runner may not be used for both. Only players not yet in the game may be used. If no substitutes are available, there is no CR.
  - The batter shall keep one foot in the box between pitches
- ❖ **Conferences**
  - Defensive: 3 per game, then pitcher is removed (can all be used in 1 inning). 1 per inning in ITB.
  - Offensive: 1 per inning between the coach and any offensive player.

## Pitching

- A pitcher may be removed as a pitcher, move to a different defensive position and return as a pitcher only once per inning provided the return as a pitcher does not violate substitution or charged conference rule.
- The pitcher must start with both feet on the rubber and movement must be forward
- Distances: 14, 16 & 18U – 43', 12&U – 40', 10&U – 35'

## ❖ Miscellaneous Tournament Information:

- **Adult tournaments** – Players do not need facemasks, jewelry may be worn, metal cleats may be used, & teams may start a game with 8 players – play at your own risk.
- **Game time is forfeit time** – to be regulated at the tournament director's discretion. In rain situation's, please do not leave the fields as the schedule may be adjusted without prior notice.
- **Home Team** shall be determined by the flip of a coin for ALL games
- **Championship Game** will not have a time limit; however the run rule will remain in place for ALL games
- **Head coach** must sign the umpire's game slip with the final score and winning team indicated. By signing, the head coach verifies that the score and winning team are correct. Once signed, the score is final.
- **We now allows the use of an EP (see below)**
- **ALL players**, both starters and substitutes, may re-enter the game one time.
- **Protests** on a "rule interpretation" will be settled by the field director in a timely manner. A \$50 cash fee is required immediately or play continues. Protests cannot be made on an umpire's "judgment" call – only rule applications.
- **Practice and warm up areas** will be designated at check in. Please do not hang or climb on field fences.
- **Forfeits:** A team may forfeit no more than one game of bracket ball and advance in elimination round play
- **Shorthanded Play: New for 2012 - A team must only have 8 players to start a game, but will record an automatic out where the 9th player would appear in the lineup.**

## ❖ Additional Information:

- Announce all substitutions to the umpire -- avoid ejections.
- Coaches must remain in the dugout during the game. Non-playing members and coaches are to remain in dead-ball territory until time has been called by the umpire.
- Please do not impede the progress of the game – any signs of poor sportsmanship, actions that demean opposing players, fans, or the umpire are subject to be removed permanently from the game and premises. Any coach / player ejected from a ball game will be reviewed by the Tournament Committee and further action **may** be taken.
- Concessions are available at all fields. You may bring coolers. Please clean up after yourselves.
- **Alcohol is forbidden at ALL complexes.**
- Additionally please do not smoke near the players. Remove yourself to the parking lot or out of the way area.
- Pets must be kept on a leash and cleaned up after unless they are prohibited from the park premises.

## ❖ More On The EP

- Any team may use 1 or 2 extra players (EP) per game and it must be made known prior to the start of the game and properly indicated on the lineup. The use of an EP without indicating as such on the lineup is an illegal player.
- The EP must remain in the same position in the batting order for the entire game.
- The EP may play defense at any time without her status being effected. She may go in and out of the defensive lineup as often as needed as long as her position in the official batting order is not altered.
- The EP may be substituted for at any time with the substitute becoming the new EP. The substitute must be a player that has not been in the game.
- Penalty for a player not remaining in the game: Short handed rule applies.

- ❖ **The Fine Print:** The Tournament Director reserves the right to adjust the rules, schedules, brackets, and field locations as needed to complete the tournament. Every attempt will be made to honor the game minimum – however, if a situation develops where a team forfeits or the weather does not cooperate the Tournament Director will make an attempt to reschedule games, shorten games, or cancel games in order to complete the tournament in a timely fashion.
